PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE, WRIT OF PROHIBITION

COME NOW Petitioners Laborers' International Union of North America, Local 169, (UNION), and RICHARD DALY, (DALY), individually, by and through their undersigned attorney, and hereby petition this Court for a Writ of Mandamus directing Respondent City of Sparks to accept the lawful bids of contractors who submitted a bid to construct the federally funded Spanish Springs Sanitary Sewer Phase 3 Project, City of Sparks Bid #08/09-029-PWP WA-2009-221, or, in the alternative that the Court issue a Write of Prohibition against Respondent City of Sparks prohibiting it from rebidding the project, (the

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"Project), and to award such contract based upon the lawful bids, or in the alternative that the Court issue a Writ of Prohibition against Respondent City of Sparks prohibiting it from rebidding the project.

This Petition is filed pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 3. Petitioners aver and allege as follows:

I

Petitioner Laborers' International Union of North America, Local 169 is a labor organization as defined under 29 USC § 152(5), affiliated with the AFL-CIO. The Union maintains offices in Reno, Nevada, and has jurisdiction for representing its members throughout Northern Nevada.

II

Petitioner Richard Daly is a citizen and resident of the City of Sparks, County of Washoe, State of Nevada, and is over the age of 21 years. Petitioner Daly is a full-time employee of Laborers' Local 169, serving as its Business Manager, and is authorized to act in its behalf and is also acting as an individual in filing this Petition.

III

Respondent City of Sparks is a municipal government entity, formed under the laws of the State of Nevada. The City is governed by its elected City Council members, and employs a City Manager who serves at the pleasure of the Council.

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On or about April 27, 2009, the City published a request for proposals to perform construction on the Spanish Springs Sanitary Sewer Phase 3 Project. The City assigned the Project Bid # 08/09-028-PWP WA-2009-221.

v

On or about May 20, 2009, the City received approximately 10 bids on the Project. Nine of the bids received by the City conformed to the request for proposals referenced above.

VI

On or about June 9, 2009, the Purchasing Manager for the City of Sparks, signed and distributed a letter to "All Bidders" and "All Plan Holders," referencing the Project. (A copy of said letter is attached hereto as Exhibit 1.) The letter stated, in relevant part:

This letter is written to inform all plan holders and bidders for the above referenced project that the City of Sparks is rejecting all bids received on May 20, 2009. This action is allowed per Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS 338.1385d) [sic] as well as the referenced bid document....

In the course of routine due diligence in evaluating bids received, the City discovered multiple issues with the original bid documents and specifications that may have led to some (or all bidders) possibly making assumptions concerning the scheduling of the job, therefore affecting prices submitted to the City. Additionally, concerns over the structure of the bid schedule and how data was to be reported to the State of Nevada were discovered. In order to be fair to all bidders, the City has determined that rejection of all bids is the best option.

A new project of similar scope will be advertised for bid sometime in the next 2 weeks. Multiple changes will be made including specific requirements

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concerning project planning/scheduling, changes to the Item Schedule and clarifications concerning contractor/subcontractor qualifications. New plan specifications will be produced distributed to all original planholders of the first bid at no cost for the sets. If plans were originally shipped to your firm, they will be shipped again in same manner (shipping costs to be paid by receiver). Otherwise, all planholders will notified when new plan sets can be picked up from the City. Firms that did not participate in the original bid cycle may also purchase their own sets.

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VII

NRS 338.1385 states, in relevant part:

NRS 338.1385 Advertising for bids and compliance with certain provisions required for commencement of certain public works; quarterly reports of awarded contracts by authorized representatives; availability of plans and specifications for public inspection; award of contract to lowest responsive and responsible bidder; rejection of bids; authority to award contract without competitive bidding if no bids received in response to advertisement for bids in certain circumstances; requirements before public body may commence public work itself; exemptions. [Effective through April 30, 2013.]

- 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 9 and NRS 338.1906 and 338.1907, this State, or a governing body or its authorized representative that awards a contract for a public work in accordance with paragraph (a) of subsection 1 of NRS 338.1373 shall not:
- (a) Commence a public work for which estimated cost exceeds \$100,000 unless it advertises in а newspaper qualified pursuant to chapter 238 of NRS that is published in the county where the public work will be performed for bids for the public work. If no qualified newspaper is published in the county where the public will be performed, the advertisement must be published in some qualified newspaper that is printed in the of Nevada and has circulation in the county.

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(b) Commence a public work for which the estimated cost is \$100,000 or less unless it complies with the provisions of NRS 338.1386, 338.13862 and 338.13864.

- (c) Divide a public work into separate portions to avoid the requirements of paragraph (a) or (b).
- 2. At least once each quarter, the authorized representative of a public body shall report to the public body any contract that the authorized representative awarded pursuant to subsection 1 in the immediately preceding quarter.
- 3. Each advertisement for bids must include a provision that sets forth the requirement that a contractor must be qualified pursuant to NRS 338.1379 or 338.1382 to bid on the contract.
- 4. Approved plans and specifications for the bids must be on file at a place and time stated in the advertisement for the inspection of all persons desiring to bid thereon and for other interested persons. Contracts for the public work must be awarded on the basis of bids received.
- 5. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 6 and NRS 338.1389, a public body or its authorized representative shall award a contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
- 6. Any bids received in response to an advertisement for bids may be rejected if the public body or its authorized representative responsible for awarding the contract determines that:
- (a) The bidder is not a qualified bidder pursuant to NRS 338.1379 or 338.1382;
- (b) The bidder is not responsive or responsible;
- (c) The quality of the services, materials, equipment or labor offered does not conform to the approved plans or specifications; or

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(d) The public interest would be served by such a rejection.

VIII

The rejection of the bids received for the Project on or about May 20, 2009, did not comply with the requirements of NRS 338.1385.

IX

The Purchasing Manager did not have legal authority to reject the bids for the Project received on or about May 20, 2009.

X

The City Council did not, at a public meeting, reject the bids for the Project received on or about May 20, 2009.

XI

The City of Sparks had a duty to award the bid on the Project to the entity that was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and that submitted its bid in accordance with Nevada law as required in the Request For Bids on May 20, 2009.

XII

The City of Sparks announced its intention to rebid the Project, or a project for the same purpose, with similar scope of work. It is Petitioners' understanding that such rebid will occur on or about July 8, 2009.

XIII

Respondent City of Sparks has acted arbitrarily and in violation of State statutes by rejecting the bids for the Project received on or about May 20, 2009.

XIV

Petitioners have no plain, speedy, or adequate remedy at law or equity other than this Petition.

XV

Petitioners have been required to obtain the services of an attorney to seek this Writ.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners pray there may be issued against Respondent City of Sparks an alternative Writ of Mandamus, returnable within ten days, compelling Respondent to award the contract on the above-referenced Project to the entity which was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and that submitted its bid in accordance with Nevada law as required in the Request For Bids on or about May 20, 2009, or to show cause why it should not do so.

In the alternative, Petitioners pray there may be issued against Respondent City of Sparks a Writ of Prohibition prohibiting it from rebidding the above-referenced Project, until it has complied with the laws of the State of Nevada governing awarding bids on the Public Works Project referenced hereinabove.
